Deloitte 2021 Manufacturing Industry Outlook: Manufacturer Preparedness & Adaptability Key to a Very Prosperous 2021

While <u>Deloitte</u> projected a 5.4% decrease in domestic manufacturing output in 2021 amidst the pandemic (Sept. 2020), the firm's "2021 <u>Manufacturing Industry Outlook Report</u>" paints a different picture – as 63% of manufacturing executives polled in November and December of 2020 were optimistic about growth and profitability in the year ahead. Based upon industry interviews, surveys and analyses, Deloitte's report identified firm investment in ERP systems, digital design software, automation and Industry 4.0 technologies as keys to a successful 2021 – with 76% of



optimistic CEOs already investing in those areas. Fortifying supply chains through reshoring, nearshoring or the creation of multiple suppler relationships and strategically upskilling employees, particularly in leadership and technology areas, were also noted as integral to manufacturer recovery and growth. These recommendations, as well as Deloitte's encouragement of fundamental production cost control practices (aka Continuous Improvement) and production line flexibility, are consistent with the industry insight of *Forbes, IndustryWeek, Grant Thorton* and others.

Specifics of December (2020) Coronavirus Relief Package Remain Nebulous

COVID-19 Vaccination Roll-Out: Manufacturing Employees Included in Phase 1B

The PA Department of Health has rolled-out the Commonwealth's <u>COVID-19 Vaccine Resources</u> page, which includes PA's <u>Vaccination Plan</u>, a helpful <u>Vaccine Toolkit</u> (which summarizes the Plan), <u>FAQs</u>, posters and other information in downloadable file formats. NEPIRC encourages manufacturing leaders, particularly those in HR roles, to review the information. Please note that



manufacturing workers are categorized as **Phase 1B Critical Workers**, which is a relatively high-priority vaccination group.
