Experts and growers gathered to consider how AI is reshaping farming at forum

Farmers have known AI to mean one thing — the birds and the bees for bulls — for quite some time, but now it's starting to mean something else.

Artificial Intelligence is set to collide with agriculture in big ways, changing how farmers approach everything from planting to harvest. At the April CIFT Agribusiness Forum, held at the Agricultural Incubator Foundation in Bowling Green, Ohio, experts and growers gathered to consider how AI is reshaping farming operations in very real, practical ways.

Wisconsin's 200-Year Manufacturing Evolution

Wisconsin serves as a critical manufacturing hub in the U.S. The sector contributes almost \$70 billion annually to the state's economy, equating to 19% of its total economic output, and employs 575,000 workers across more than 92,000 manufacturing firms.

The "Badger State" owes its nickname to its long manufacturing heritage. In the 1820s and 1830s, lead mining brought thousands of poor workers to the state, and they survived its harsh winters by burrowing holes into the hillsides for shelter. Wisconsin residents started to refer to them as badgers, owing to their animal-like behavior, and the association stuck; in 1889, the University of Wisconsin adopted the badger mascot.

By the mid-1800s, Wisconsin's rapid population growth saw a sharp uptick in agricultural and industrial activity.

Creating Jobs in Westmoreland County: Shapiro-Davis Administration Secures \$13.6 Million Investment from Premier Automation to Expand its Manufacturing Operation and Create and Retain Jobs in Westmoreland County

On June 12th, Governor Josh Shapiro announced that the Commonwealth is investing more than \$3 million to support Premier Automation's (Premier) manufacturing expansion in Westmoreland County. The engineered solutions company, which specializes in creating and upgrading industrial robotic automation systems to help businesses run more efficiently, will inject \$13.6 million into the local economy, create 111 new jobs, and retain at least 130 existing positions over the next five years.

Premier has purchased a 170,000-square-foot building at 3700 Haney Court in Murrysville to expand its manufacturing operations. As part of its commitment to the Commonwealth, the company is also maintaining all existing operations at its headquarters in Monroeville, Allegheny County.

Shapiro Administration Secures \$15.4 Million Investment from Berner International to Expand Manufacturing Operations and Create Over 70 New Jobs in Lawrence County

On June 11th, Governor Josh Shapiro announced the Commonwealth is investing \$3 million to support <u>Berner International's</u> (Berner) expansion of its manufacturing operation in Lawrence County, which will inject \$15.4 million into the local economy, create at least 74 new jobs, and retain at least 127 existing positions over the next three years.

Berner will construct a 55,000-square-foot addition to its manufacturing facility

located at 111 Progress Avenue in Shenango Township. This expansion will allow the company to scale up production capacity, introduce advanced manufacturing technologies, and enhance logistical operations, enabling it to remain competitive and grow in the global marketplace. Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) Secretary Rick Siger joined Berner leadership to help break ground on the facility's addition.

Shapiro Administration Secures \$30 Million Investment from Pittston Co-Packers Corp. to Open First American Production Operation and Create Hundreds of New Jobs in Luzerne County

on June 23rd, Governor Josh Shapiro announced that <u>Pittston Co-Packers Corp</u>. will open its first beverage production operation in the U.S, injecting \$30 million into the local economy and creating at least 226 new, full-time jobs in Luzerne County within the next three years. The Commonwealth is investing more than \$1 million to support this new production operation.

The company has acquired the equipment and balance of Joriki Beverages' lease at 575 Research Drive in Pittston Township, which permanently closed in January 2025. Pittston Co-Packers Corp. will produce beverages for top U.S. brand contracts that were held by Joriki, and provide job opportunities for that company's former employees.




