

## Youth Apprenticeship Program

Would you like to learn about what kinds of jobs are available in manufacturing?

Are you interested in learning skills that could lead to a rewarding career and employment opportunities?

If you answered “Yes” to any of the above questions, then you might want to consider the **NEPIRC Youth Apprenticeship Program.**

### Requirements:

#### *Eligible students:*

- Must be at least 16-years-old and have completed 10th grade.
- Receive parent approval
- Must have transportation to and from the workplace.
- Must be enrolled in a participating school district.
- Will commit to the development of workplace skills and gaining knowledge of a career in manufacturing.
- Will maintain passing grades in all subjects.
- Will agree to no more than five (5) absences per semester.
- Will maintain good disciplinary standing.

### You can expect to:

- Spend about one to two days a week at the workplace with a Mentor provided by the employee. The Mentor is a skilled technician, craftsman or journeyman who will assist the student with workplace learning.
- Continue academic learning at school four days a week to create a strong foundation on which to build workplace skills.
- Receive the support of the Youth Apprenticeship Program Coordinator to monitor all phases of the school-to-industry transition.
- Be evaluated by the mentor/supervisor and be expected to complete a weekly log of work activities.
- Be awarded credit for participating in the apprenticeship program.

### To Apply:

Simply complete a Youth Apprenticeship Program application and return it to your guidance counselor for grades and attendance information. You will be notified of your status in the program.
