Biden-Harris Administration Announces \$50 Million to Incentivize Smart Manufacturing at Small and Medium-Sized Facilities

Through the U.S. Department of Energy State Manufacturing Leadership Program, \$50 million in funding from President Biden's Bipartisan Infrastructure Law will ensure that smart manufacturing technologies and high-performance computing are more accessible by domestic manufacturing firms. The program aims to remove existing barriers that prevent innovative, data-driven tools and technologies from being used by small and mid-sized manufacturers (SMMs). The program also provides states and territories an opportunity to connect SMMs with a diverse coalition of public and private technical assistance providers, such as the Manufacturing USA institutes, the national



laboratories, NIST Manufacturing Extension Partnerships, Industrial Assessment Centers and institutions of higher education.

Pennsylvania Places 8th in the Nation for Major Economic Development Projects

According to Site Selection Magazine, an internationally-

recognized and a worldwide-circulated publication of Conway Data that summarizes commercial real estate and economic development activity, Pennsylvania was the 8th-ranked state in the nation for major economic development projects in 2022. Site Selector's 2022 year-end edition, published in late-March, stated that Pennsylvania's 230 significant company relocation or expansion projects moved the Commonwealth up four positions from its 12th-place ranking in 2021. Pennsylvania held its 2nd-place ranking across the Northeastern United States.

American Paper Bag, located in Sugar Notch, PA, is experiencing explosive growth due in part to home deliveries driving higher demand for paper bags, along with plastic bag bans in most states. As a result, the company is expanding and hiring.



American Paper Bag is a leading provider of revolutionary, customizable and environmentally friendly paper shopping bags and mailers with customization options. Since the manufacturer's opening five years ago in a 44,000-square foot building, the company has since doubled in size and will soon expand to 100,000 square feet.

One of American Paper Bag's biggest customers is Walmart. The manufacturer makes bags for the retail giant's home deliveries. Another big customer is the consumer goods and food delivered company, Gopuff, headquartered in Philadelphia.

"We've got new equipment coming in and more machinery on the way. Our orders have just gone ballistic in the last six to 12 months, so we're doing very well at the moment. We just need more staffing to do it," said Ian Robson, company founder.

- Reversible Winter Skirt (Apparel Item) Great opportunity for an apparel, textile or embroidery company to get in with a start-up! Call is for long winter-style skirts that will be reversible and held on by ring snaps. One side will be warm faux fur while the other is a smooth, fashion-forward velvet-like fabric. Process consists of sewing 4 fronts and 2 backs along side seams and adding waistband. Skirt will feature pockets (to be sewn in) and 16 snaps along waistband. Fabric will be provided. Skirt comes in three different sizes. Initial buy will be 300 of each of 3 sizes 900 total at desired price of about \$30/unit. Entrepreneur is located on Colorado and available for consultation regarding manufacturability of product.
- Polypropylene 3015 Resin Pellets Minnesota-based company seeking domestic supplier of bulk-packed Polypropylene 3015 Resin Pellets to manufacture a new style of child-safe medication bottle lids. The end-product, which the Minnesota company will manufacture, will be injection-molded. The plastic pellet input must meet 16CFR-1700 certification requirements and 21CFR-177.1520 FDA regulations for food contact. Initial order will be 1,000 lbs./month and is expected to rise once a major TV retail channel airs multiple showings of the bottle and lid configuration. Company eager to either deal directly with a Pennsylvania-based supplier or obtain information, as a manufacturer-to-manufacturer courtesy, as to where other companies are purchasing their pellets.
- REPOST PA-Based Opportunity Rectangular Hollow Extruded Copper (for

Box Connector) – Pennsylvania company seeking to reshore supplier of copper extrusions for subsequent machining into box connectors for electrical switches. Outside rectangle .737 x .466/.455 with .015+/-.010 corner radii. Symmetrical inside rectangle .462/.432 x .326/.323 with inside corner radii of .010+/-.005. Extrusion length is 10 foot. Material is 120 Copper Alloy with B2-B54 Rockwell Hardness rating. Straight extrusions are important as the product will be channel-fed into CNC for further processing. Order is for 20,000 to 40,000 feet/yr (2,000 to 4,000 10-foot extrusions). Desired price point is \$110.00/10-feet.
