Shapiro Admin and PA DCED Secretary Siger Unveil 10-Year Economic Development Strategy

Over the past year, the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) has been working hard on developing a comprehensive, 10-year economic development strategy – the first of its kind in nearly two decades. On January 30, Gov. Josh Shapiro and PA DCED Secretary Rick Siger officially unveiled the new strategy in the Lehigh Valley. The goals are clear – they want to make Pennsylvania a premier state to do business, outcompete other states, and build a stronger Commonwealth that works for all the residents, workers, businesses and entrepreneurs that call Pennsylvania home. Pennsylvania Manufacturers Report Significant Benefits and Impacts from Statewide Industrial Resource Center (IRC) Program

According to data voluntarily provided by 575 small and mid-sized manufacturing firms across Pennsylvania throughout 2023, the statewide Industrial Resource Center (IRC) initiative, the Commonwealth's flagship program for strengthening the competitiveness and resiliency of smaller industrial firms, generated significant positive results among users of their services. Over the past 12 months, manufacturers that utilized IRC professional services avoided 7,197 layoffs while adding 1,462 full-time workers to their rosters. They also realized \$796.8 million in retained sales and secured \$256.4 million of new customer orders as results of their IRC advisement and engagements.

In addition to growing their workforces and increasing their top-line revenue numbers, companies that performed consultative projects with their regional IRC reduced their non-personnel operating costs by \$187.1 million over the past 12 months, avoided \$36 million of unnecessary expenditures, and invested more than \$376.8 million in new equipment, facility expansion, advanced technologies and workforce training.

NEPIRC is relaying these potential new business opportunities to manufacturers across our region:

- Plastic Buckets with Lids Manufacturer seeking provider of 13-gallon and 6.5-gallon buckets with snapping lids. Design is similar to existing buckets used for spackle, cat litter, paint and other constructor or household items. Can be blow molded or injection molded with 90 mm gauge throughout. 6.5gallon version will be 13.5 x 12 x 13.75 (inches) stackable up to 300 lbs. 13gallon version will be 16.5 x 13.5 x 18.5 (inches) stackable to 200 lbs. Company will purchase 1,500 of the 6.5-gallon version per year and 11,000 of the 13-gallon version per year. Desired price-point is around \$12.50/unit for the smaller version and \$20.50/unit for the larger. Contact <u>SupplierScouting@NEPIRC.com</u> with interest in learning more.
- Circular Sheet Metal Cover & Cylindrical Housing Massachusetts company seeking supplier of circular sheet metal piece with diameter of 24.29" with multiple openings. Finished product will be 0.04" thickness and fully finished with a rustproof coating or paint. Company is also seeking provider of a 0.04" thickness cylindrical housing with various cut-outs and holes. Technical drawings are available through SupplierScouting@NEPIRC.com. Process involves metal stamping, forming, finishing, painting and screw tapping. Buyer to ramp-up purchases from 1,000/yr. to 10,000/yr. Price point is \$30 for the cover unit and \$65 for the cylindrical housing.
- Tempered Glass Product Company in Missouri seeking a supplier with ability to procure and cut 3.2mm (1/8 inch) tempered glass to given specifications with rounded edges. Glass panels will be four-sided and generally have a larger top dimension than bottom, creating somewhat of a "funnel" look. Buyer has 33 different sizes ranging from 159 mm (top) x 67 mm (bottom) x 175 mm (sides) to 387 mm (top) x 197 (bottom) x 457 (sides). Buyer will procure more than 46,000 units/yr. across all sizes.
