CHIPS for America Funding Opportunity Expanded

To establish a vibrant domestic semiconductor industry, the U.S. must invest across the semiconductor supply chain – including the upstream materials and manufacturing equipment critical to chip manufacturing. As part of implementing the bipartisan CHIPS and Science Act, the Department of Commerce is releasing two funding opportunities for suppliers. The first, launched on June 23, 2023, expands the scope of the February 2023 funding opportunity to include <u>projects for the construction, expansion</u> or modernization of semiconductor materials and <u>manufacturing equipment facilities</u> for which the capital investment equals or exceeds \$300 million. The second, to be released in the fall of 2023, will seek applications for



semiconductor materials and manufacturing equipment facilities with capital investments below \$300 million.

Shapiro Announces EAM-Mosca to Invest \$20.6M to Expand Operation

In late June, Gov. Josh Shapiro said <u>EAM-Mosca Corp.</u>, a leading provider of automatic strapping systems used in commercial packaging that is headquartered in Hazleton, will invest \$20.6 million to expand its manufacturing operation in Luzerne County, creating at least 50 new good-paying jobs within the next three years.



With support from the <u>Department of</u> <u>Community and Economic</u>

<u>Development</u>, Shapiro said the packaging system manufacturer will renovate its existing facility and purchase new machinery and equipment for its Hazle Township campus at 675 Jaycee Drive.

The \$9 million complete renovation of 525 Jaycee Drive is adjacent to EAM-Mosca's existing headquarters at 675 Jaycee Drive. The new facility is part of a larger \$20.6 million strategic initiative to expand the company's operational footprint within the state in the coming years. It allows for the retention of 157 employees statewide and the creation of 50 new positions. NEPIRC was present at the groundbreaking ceremony to congratulate EAM-Mosca on this exciting endeavor!



Modern Casting Names Benton Foundry Metalcaster of the Year

<u>Benton Foundry</u>, located in Benton, PA, was named Metalcaster of the Year by *Modern Casting* in its June issue!

Benton Foundry is a world-class foundry that showcases a commitment to smart, incremental and consistent reinvestment. Most recently, the iron metalcaster has completed one of the largest expansions in its history, which involved 70,000 sq. ft. of new and renovated space to improve and enhance its coremaking capabilities. Finished in the fall of 2022, the expansion increased capacity, improved process control, enhanced efficiency and added 50 new jobs. It is because of this accomplishment that *Modern Casting* named Benton Foundry its "Metalcaster of the Year." The core room capital investment project is just the latest example of the modernization and growth mindset established by Fritz Hall in the 1970s and adhered to ever since. His son, Jeff Hall, Benton Foundry president since 2013, has carried on the legacy. "My father was very motivated to turn this into a successful business, as was his father AJ Hall," Jeff Hall said. "And the mindset

was always to keep the profits in the business and to reinvest them. As a result of that mindset, they started working off five-year CapEx, cash-flow budget plans in the mid-1970s. And we continue to do that to this day. We are now in our ninth five-year plan. So, our modernization mindset has been in place for basically 45 years."

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

For the month of July <u>NEPIRC's Wise Words Book</u> <u>Club</u> is reading <u>Dare to Lead</u> by Brené Brown.

Book summary: Leadership is not about titles, status, and wielding power. A leader is anyone who takes responsibility for recognizing the potential in people and ideas, and has the courage to develop that potential.

When we dare to lead, we don't pretend to have the right answers; we stay curious and ask the right questions. We don't see power as finite and hoard it; we know that power becomes infinite when we share it with others. We don't avoid difficult conversations and situations; we lean into vulnerability when it's necessary to do good work.



But daring leadership in a culture defined by scarcity, fear, and uncertainty requires skillbuilding around traits that are deeply and uniquely human. The irony is that we're choosing not to invest in developing the hearts and minds of leaders at the exact same time as we're scrambling to figure out what we have to offer that machines and AI can't do better and faster. What can we do better? Empathy, connection, and courage, to start.

Four-time #1 New York Times bestselling author Brené Brown has spent the past two decades studying the emotions and experiences that give meaning to our lives, and the past seven years working with transformative leaders and teams spanning the globe. She found that leaders in organizations ranging from small entrepreneurial startups and family-owned businesses to nonprofits, civic organizations, and Fortune 50 companies all ask the same question:

How do you cultivate braver, more daring leaders and how do you embed the value of courage in your culture?

New Business Opportunities: Companies Looking for Suppliers

NEPIRC is relaying these potential new business opportunities to manufacturers across our region:

- Zinc Coating of Brass Parts Arkansas-based manufacturer of brass parts is seeking a supplier to provide zinc coating services for its products. Brass parts are 3/8" diameter by 1" length including threads. These parts go into water heater assemblies. The zinc coating applied must be red and must be permanent. Simple use of red ink is not sufficient. However, there is no specification on the exact shade of red. Volume would be between 300 and 500 lbs. of brass parts annually typically in two or three batches per year. Desired price point between \$1.08 and \$1.40 per lb.
- Paper Food Container New product start-up seeking a supplier of a paper container for its food product. Rough measurements, which can be discussed with supplier (to avoid tooling costs if possible) are 5.5" to 6" top diameter and 5.2" to 6" depth. The container will have a slight slope to the sides so bottom diameter will be less than top. Product does not need to be wax-coated, but buyer would consider a wax-coated item. Thickness of paper can be discussed with supplier, but a thinner-than-usual container would be acceptable since contents are dry and light. No moisture or liquids will be added to the product for preparation or consumption. Buyer anticipates first-year demand of 2.8M units.
- Transformer Arizona company seeking supplier of a transformer to be used in a new 208-240 volt AC power supply. Transformer consists of coil winding on commercially available bobbins and cores. Buyer has technical specifications and drawings, which will be passed along to potential suppliers upon request. Technical specs include dimensions (approx. 5"x5.5"x6" finished); weight (approx. 30 lbs); 0.97:1.03 isolation transformer; 120 VAC, 20A continuous; 180 degrees C, Class F. Must be assembled to UL Standard 1012. Purchase will be for 400 units in first year of buyer-supplier relationship and increasing thereafter. Potential suppliers should contact NEPIRC for more specifications.
