Pennsylvania Governor Josh Shapiro Releases 2023-2024 State Budget

Pennsylvania Governor Josh Shapiro revealed his 2023-2024 proposed budget for the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania on March 7th, 2023. Items of relevance to manufacturers consist of the formation of a Foundations in Industry initiative to stimulate the development of Apprentice and Pre-Apprentice programs throughout the state; an increase in Guaranteed Free Training (or WEDNetPA), which many



manufacturers access to upskill their workforce; and significant increases in funding programs to modernize CTC-based training programs and assist CTCs in obtaining the equipment needed to train our future manufacturing workforce in the latest advanced industrial technologies.

The Governor also proposed an increase to Pennsylvania's minimum wage, an accelerated reduction of the CNI tax and expedited permitting and business licensure policies. A full compilation of proposed budget documents can be found by <u>CLICKING</u> HERE.




Leadership Is Language – the Next NEPIRC Wise Words Book Club Read

- Rotary Manifold Seals lowa company seeking domestic suppliers of seals used in rotary manifolds. Buyer is seeking sizes in .5" increments from 1.5" diameter to 10" diameter. Looking for circuit seals made of oil-embedded nylon (ny-oil or nylatron), PTFE blends (graphite, bronze, carbon fiber) and/or urethane and lathe cut and other products. Drawings will be provided for a number of seal products. If your company has experience in lathe cut seals and rotary applications, please contact NEPIRC for more information. Buyer is domestically sourcing more than 100 parts with annual consumption of 200-2,500 units per part.
- Ultra-Microbalance North Carolina company seeking supplier of an ultramicrobalance capable of providing gravimetric analysis of airborne particle matter filter samples that have been collected in an ambient environment. These are metal and electronic assemblies of approximate dimensions of 23/6" X 14.6" X 19.3". Desired per-unit cost is in the \$51,000 range. - Reflective Mylar Film Colorado buyer seeking reflective mylar film sheet 90" width (on roll). This film will be stretched over an aluminum frame to create a lightweight reflective mirror panel (80" X 80") for immersive video projection. Standard film manufacturing process to achieve 90% reflectivity. Thickness should be greater than 1mil to allow for stretching without breaking. Company is receptive to other reflective substrates. Purchase rate is currently 170 linear feet per month. Desired target price is \$1,000 per 100 linear feet.
