Announcing the National Strategy for U.S. Leadership in Advanced Manufacturing

On Manufacturing Day in October, the White House released the <u>National</u> <u>Strategy for Advanced Manufacturing</u>. Manufacturing drives America's economy and national security. To help the United States remain a global leader, the Biden-Harris administration is focused on efforts that revitalize the manufacturing sector, build strong U.S. supply chains, invest in research and development (R&D) and train the workforce that will secure our global economic position. This quadrennial strategy outlines a vision for the U.S. to

DOD Releases Report on Defense Spending by State in Fiscal Year 2021; Pennsylvania Ranked 10th

The Department of Defense's Office of Local Defense Community Cooperation recently released its Fiscal Year 2021 Defense Spending by State Report to help states and communities better understand the components of defense spending on procurement and personnel.

The report's graphs, maps, and tables present a range of findings, such as total spending figures, categories of contracted



goods and services, major defense vendors and numbers and types of defense personnel. This snapshot provides public and private leaders with a starting place to assess how defense investments across installations and the private sector can be optimized by supporting regional innovation, industrial capability and capacity, supply chain resilience and cultivating a skilled workforce. New, Lower Corporate Net Income Tax Rate Approved

Pennsylvania Governor Tom Wolf announced that Pennsylvania is on a path to a 4.99% corporate net income tax (CNIT) rate. The reduction will halve the state's CNIT rate and place Pennsylvania among the lowest CNIT rates in the nation.

"This lower rate is a game-changer for business in PA. We're going to ensure tax fairness, make Pennsylvania a top location for businesses and bring new, good-paying jobs here for Pennsylvanians," says Governor Wolf. <u>CLICK HERE</u> to learn more about CNIT reduction.

- Fabric for Sport Shoes (Sneakers) Colorado-based manufacturer seeking water-resistant, breathable, tear-resistant fabric of various colors for making of sneakers and sport-specific footwear. Current provider has limited color selection and is inconsistent in provision of product. Rolls of fabric should be 61" maximum width. Fabric should be a non-nylon blend or full polyester. Seeking to purchase 300 yards/year of each selected color.
